Form F - Food Concessions and Vendors offering Food Samples

Requirements and Procedure for Food Concessions and Vendors Offering Food Samples:

Provincial Regulations require that Vendors, including those running food concessions or providing any edible samples, must have an approved Health Department “Special Events Temporary Food Establishment Permit” and a Food Safe Certificate.

Complete this form and the general vendor application and submit them to the market managers. If you are approved as a Food Concession or vendor who offers food samples, you will be sent the required Vancouver Island Health Authority (VIHA) “Application to Operate a Temporary Food Service” with the CVCM information included.

Forward a copy of your VIHA approved “Special Events Temporary Food Establishment Permit” to the market managers. Copies of the VIHA permit and Food Safe Certificate must be received by the market managers before you can set up. Both need to be displayed in your booth at every market.
